Dpt. Gee Creek at 7 a.m. on I-5 North Rest stops as needed Rest stop at Scatter Creek MP 90 ~ 8:15 (~ 80 miles from Gee Creek) Rest stop at Sea-Tac – 7 Miles N. of Tacoma (~MP 140 at Weigh Station) Meet up with the Marque Club of Seattle TBD Arv. Bellingham Exit 256 A for SR-539 North at ~12:00 Lunch and Gas Stop Dpt. Bellingham for Boarder Crossing at Aldergrove (SR-539 N.) to BC-13.

Continue on BC-13N to CA-1 (Trans-Canada Hwy) West to BC-99 N to Squamish.

Arrive Squamish ~3:30, From Bellingham to Squamish is about 100 miles but the border crossing can add some travel time. For those not planning of going to Edmonton, they would head home on the 30th.

The following options are provided for your consideration and Comments;

Option 1

Follow-on Cruise to Edmonton, CA

(Prices are in Canadian Dollars)

Following the Squamish event, consideration is being given for a drive to Edmonton, CA via Kamloops, Lake Louise, Banff, and Calgary before heading home. Below is a draft route:

Dpt. Squamish on 30 Aug for Kamloops – about 4.5 hour drive 416K (258Miles) spend the night in Kamloops. Hotels are ~ \$125 incl. Taxes

Dpt. Kamloops on 31 Aug for Lake Louise and Banff– about a 5 hour drive 443 K (275 Miles). Tour Lake Louise and Banff. Banff is about an hour SE of Lake Louise. Plan on spending the night close to Banff <u>but not in Banff</u> ~ around \$125 incl. Taxes.

Dept. Banff on 1 Sept. for Edmonton and the largest mall in North America – West Edmonton Mall. It's about a 4 hour drive, 420K (260 Miles) via Calgary. There is another route from Banff going north back past Lake Louise to Edmonton.

Spend Sept. 1st and 2nd in Edmonton and the Mall

Depart Edmonton on 3 Sep. for Bonners Ferry, ID. About an 8 hour drive 824K (512 Miles) <u>**OR**</u> Spend the afternoon and evening in Calgary.

Dpt Calgary on 4 Sep for Sandpoint, ID. About 6.5 hour drive 353, miles.

Dep. Sand point, ID for Home about 6.5 hours and 419 Miles. Arrive back home on 5 September Sat.

Options 2 and 3 Cruise to Edmonton, CA

In consideration of the planned cruise to Edmonton after the Squamish event, the next and biggest Corvette Event in Western Canada will be the following weekend in Edmonton, September 4th, 5th and 6th. Because of this event, there are 2 possible alternatives:

1. As noted in Option 1, above, again depart Squamish on 30 Aug for Kamloops, then onto a Lake Louise, and Banff, spending an additional night in Banff. This would allow time to tour both Banff and Lake Louise. On 3 Sept, depart Banff for Edmonton and the West Edmonton Mall.

The Canadian Council of Corvette Clubs is holding its Convention in Edmonton on 4, 5 and 6^{th} of September 2020. We would head home on the 6^{th} of September with 1, possible 2 nights on the road.

2. The second option is to forgo the Squamish event and head directly to Edmonton, with stops in Spokane and Calgary. Departing from Gee Creek on 1 Sept. and arriving in Edmonton on 3 Sept. The return route home would be from Edmonton to Lake Louise, Banff, then to Kamloops, Abbotsford, Bellingham and home.
